Impacts included temporary closures, damage to or destruction of permitted equipment or records, and support buildings or structures, loss of power, telephone, internet and other communication and utility services, and loss of access to the equipment and buildings. Impacts are ongoing.

Proposed order for abatement: Allow sources an extension until June 30, 2019 to assess records available and submit records or certification of loss to the APCO to comply with permit conditions.
