RULE 224 - DELIVERY VESSELS NOT EQUIPPED WITH VAPOR RECOVERY

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- 1. LOADING REQUIREMENTS
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RULE 224

- 1 **LOADING REQUIREMENTS:** No owner or operator of any delivery vessel which is <u>not</u> equipped with vapor recovery shall load, permit the loading, or provide equipment for the loading of such a vessel unless the gasoline is loaded through a submerged fill pipe or its equivalent as approved by the Air Pollution Control Officer.
- **2 UNLOADING REQUIREMENTS:** The owner or operator of any delivery vessel which is <u>not</u> equipped with vapor recovery shall only unload gasoline to storage tanks which are <u>not</u> equipped with a Phase I vapor recovery system.
- **VAPOR-TIGHT REQUIREMENTS:** Except when loading any delivery vessel which is <u>not</u> equipped with vapor recovery, no person shall store gasoline in or otherwise use or operate any delivery vessel unless such vessel is designed and maintained to be vapor-tight.
